**MOTION FOR BLOOD
GROUP TESTING**

COMES NOW the plaintiff, by and through counsel, and moves the Court pursuant to G.S. § 8-50.1(b) and Rule 35 of the North Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure for an order requiring the parties and the minor child who is the subject of this action to undergo a blood group testing and analysis. In support of said motion, the plaintiff respectfully shows unto the Court as follows:

1. This is an action filed by the plaintiff on _____, in which the plaintiff seeks to establish the paternity of her minor child, _____, born _____, and an order for child support, both retroactive and prospective and attorney fees.
2. The parties hereto are not married to one another and have never been married to each other.
3. The defendant has filed answer denying paternity, and therefore, the blood group of the parties and of said minor child is in controversy.
4. Good cause exists for the plaintiff, the defendant and the minor child to submit to a blood group testing and analysis so that the true paternity of the minor child may be determined.
5. The plaintiff is a student at _____, working part-time, and good cause exists for the Court to require the defendant to pay the initial costs of the blood group testing and analysis.

WHEREFORE, the plaintiff prays that the Court enter an order requiring the plaintiff, the defendant, and the minor child to submit to a blood group testing and analysis; that the costs of said tests be taxed initially to the defendant; and for such other and further relief as to the Court may seem just and proper.
